Wednesday December the 28th 1896

this day strong wind from the ESE steard
to the NE at 4 A M steard to the NE under
all sail the watch imployed at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 22.10 Song 143.10 463

Thursday December the 29th 1896

this day commenced and ends with a gale
at 6 P M saw a ship steard to the S
at 10 A M spoke the ship Cortis Cruiser 29th
2100 hulls of oil
So ends this day Satt 21.10 Song 143.10 464

Friday December the 30th 1896

this day pleasant weather wind from the ESE steard
to the NE under all sail the watch imployed at
mending sails
So ends this day Satt 21.10 Song 143.10 465

Saturday December the 31st 1896
this day pleasant weather saw nothing worth
note except a ship wind from the ESE light
So ends this day Satt 21.10 Song 143.10 466

Sunday January the 1st 1897
this day pleasant weather wind from the
SE to the NE steard to the NE under all sail
So ends this day Satt 21.10 Song 143.10 467

Monday January the 2nd 1897

this day pleasant weather wind from the SE
steard to the S saw nothing worth mention in
the watch imployed at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 22.10 Song 143.10 468

Tuesday January the 3rd 1897

this day pleasant weather wind very light
from the SE steard to the S the watch
imployed at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 29.10 Song 144.10 469

Wednesday January the 4th 1897

this day pleasant weather light wind from the
SE steard to the S saw a small ship the watch
imployed at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 29.10 Song 144.10 470

Thursday January the 5th 1897

this day light wind and fine weather steard
the watch imployed at mending sails
Saw nothing that was worth remarking
So ends this day Satt 24.10 Song 144.10 471

Friday January the 6th 1897

this day commenced with strong wind from
the SE steard to the NE under short sail
So ends this day Satt 24.10 Song 144.10 472

Saturday January the 7th 1897

this day strong gale from the SE steard to
the South under short sail at 2 A M saw
a ship to the leeward saw a small ship
So ends this day Satt 24.10 Song 144.10 473

Sunday January the 8th 1897

this day a strong gale from the E steard to the
S at 6 A M saw a ship to the NE at 9 A M saw a large ship
at steering SE under full sail
So ends this day Satt 24.10 Song 144.10 474
