Wednesday January the 25<sup>th</sup> 1894  
this day strong winds from the N with rain  
steard to the E under short sail saw nothing  
So Ends this day Satt 27.11.48 Long 143.11.06 491

Thursday January the 26<sup>th</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather but light winds from  
the N steard to the NNE under full sail  
At 9 AM went to the E saw nothing northward  
So Ends this day Satt 28.11.48 Long 142.11.17 492

Friday January the 27<sup>th</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather winds from the  
E steard to the E under full sail  
So Ends this day Satt 29.11.48 Long 142.11.30 493

Saturday January the 28<sup>th</sup> 1894  
this day day pleasant weather winds from  
the E steard to the NNE under easy sail  
At 6 AM commenced stowing down  
So Ends this day Satt 30.11.48 Long 141.11.30 494

Sunday January the 29<sup>th</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather winds from the  
E steard to the NNE under full sail At  
9 AM saw a small boat & hauled it  
and tried the pump now to hault  
So Ends this day Satt 31.11.48 Long 140.11.30 495

Monday January the 31<sup>st</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather winds from the E steard  
At 11 AM under full sail At 10 AM saw the island  
of pil starts having 1 1/2 leagues  
So Ends this day Satt 22.12.48 Long 140.11.44 496

Tuesday January the 31<sup>st</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather winds from the E  
At 7 AM saw a small boat & hauled it long side  
At 9 AM 2 boats went to shore to trade  
recovered At 11 AM the boats returned with  
load of potatoes  
So Ends this day Satt 23.12.48 Long 141.11.44 497

Wednesday February the 1<sup>st</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather winds from the E  
the 2 boats at shore & trading At 4 PM  
the boats returned to the ship with a load  
of potatoes we hauled sail & steard to the  
NNE to the leeward of the island then  
hauled to the wind & hauled short sail  
At 4 PM we were ship to the S At 1 PM  
hauled sail At 11 PM the land bore N E dist  
4 leagues So Ends this day 498

Thursday February the 2<sup>nd</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather winds from the E  
steard to the SE with full short sail  
sail At 9 AM hauled sail saw nothing  
So Ends this day Satt 24.12.48 Long 140.11.05 499

Friday February the 3<sup>rd</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather with rain winds from  
the E steard to the SE under full sail  
saw nothing So Ends this day Satt 25.12.48 Long 140.11.05 500

Saturday February the 4<sup>th</sup> 1894  
this day pleasant weather winds from the E  
At 4 PM on board the boat to sail  
to nether So Ends this day Long 140.11.05 501
