

Sunday February the 5th 1894
This day light winds from the E. At 12 pm. A
shock of long whirly Sward & boats the
maist boat got back the other whirly
went to the Sward & boats in house returned
with out success At 4 pm took the whirly &
long side and shortened sail headed to the S.
At 6 pm. Commenced cutting & at 8 pm. got
them cutting and more ship to the S.
So ends this day Lat 24.00 Long 174.45 402

Monday February the 6th 1894
All the day squally weather with
p. of rain we are impeded by hailing
winds from the E. Steered to the S.
under short sail.
So ends this day Lat 24.49 Long 175.50 409

Tuesday February the 7th 1894
This day frosty part squally weather
with rain steered to the S. under
short sail At 4 pm. got them hailing
at 6 pm. made sail wind halled round
from the S. Steered E. S. E.
So ends this day Lat 26.11 Long 175.11 404

Wednesday February the 8th 1894
This day present weather from the S.
steered to the E. under full sail.
So ends this day Lat 26.44 Long 174.90 405

Thursday February the 9th 1894
This day light wind and more hail with
sun rain At 9 pm. saw devil bratches
steered to the E. under full sail.
So ends this day Lat 27.11 Long 174.00 406

Friday February the 10th 1894
This day squally weather and more hail
winds. So ends this day Lat 27.50 Long 174.00 407

Saturday February the 11th 1894
This day strong winds from the E. Steered
to the S. under the press sail At 10 pm.
Spoke the heavier of halapaw cattle & 9 other
cut 1400 blbls of oil
So ends this day Lat 27.44 Long 175.11 408

Sunday February the 12th 1894
This day commenced with strong and increasing
with squales of rain & winds from the E.
steered to the S. shortened sail At 4 pm.
At 9 pm. took the Sward & boats of line
& Monts 2000 blbls of oil this day ends with
a gale of wind
So ends this day Lat 27.50 Long 176.19 409

Monday February the 13th 1894
This day a strong gale from the E. Steered
to the S. At 8 pm. more ship to the S.
shortened sail At the gale increase
At 11 pm. sent down the top galant
yards and took in the main top sail.
So ends this day

Tuesday February the 14th 1894
The first part of severe gale At 9 pm.
the gale I hated we got the main
top sail and bore sail hiked to the S.
At 6 pm. made sail and more to the S.
So ends this day Lat 26.27 Long 177.00 411

Wednesday February the 15th 1894
This day light winds from the E. Steered
to the S. under easy sail At 9 pm.
Commenced stowing down oil So ends
So ends this day Lat 24.00 Long 177.11 412

Thursday February the 16th 1894
This day strong wind from the E. Steered
So ends this day Lat 24.40 Long 177.30 419
