on shore now we must try to get the
ship on the other tack. And gained it still
with our fore sail was hoisted from the yard
and split on top sails but with the aid of
our land the wind changed in the open set
trent of the campus and we drifted off
shore the ship behaved remarkably well
So ends this day of the day of 1894

Monday March the 4th 1894
this day the first part of the morning
hazy rain at 11 AM it cleared at 4 PM the
see got quite clear we commenced hauling
sails at 1 PM sail and 11th and 12th
top sail the latter part of the day
in flood at repairing sails the day
ends with a strong breeze of on land

So ends this day

Tuesday March the 5th 1894
this day first part strong winds from
the NW the mid and late part moderate
weather at 1 PM it broke the rain clouds
9 miles out to sea oil barrel boats in
the hazy rain the land was 14 miles by 8
1st 95 miles the watch in flood at
repairing sails
So ends this day

Wednesday March the 6th 1894
the first part strong winds at 4 PM
had a heavy squall from the S took in
all sail the mid and latter part moderate
weather at 6 PM it came down and back
the watch in flood at mending sails
at 7 PM the fore top sail and 11th
So ends this day

Thursday March the 7th 1894
this day pleasant weather calm squalls and a
head wind at 6 PM it came a ship & commenced
out at 11 PM Cape Horn here 8th by 8 PM
sailed with the wind at head in squalls
tried hard but could not get in this
day still hands in flood at hauling
chains and getting them on deck 560
So ends this day

Friday March the 8th 1894
this day heavy squalls and calm at 6 PM
took in all sail for a premonition of rain
we are in flood at hauling up with the
land at 11 PM entered the bay with
sudden squalls and it heard from 1 small boat
been the day round to the 14th 561
So ends this day

Saturday April the 1st 1894
this day pleasant weather with the wind
from the NW at head at 4 PM came to the
Anker in heave and both ends of water
at 8 PM it got it up of each shore for
water So ends this day 562

Sunday April the 2nd 1894
this day pleasant weather the men & shore
on liberty at 1 PM it had a squall of rain
So ends this day 563

Monday April the 3rd 1894
this day pleasant the ship & crew
on duty getting water and meat
So ends this day 564

Tuesday April the 4th 1894
this day pleasant weather the crew are in flood
at getting potatoes & food and getting water
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
