

Thursday June the 8th 1894 Days out 692
this day fair part day weather the mid part
the latter part more moderate weather said
all sail steered to the N
So ends this day

Friday June the 9th 1894 Days out 693
all this day moderate breeze from the NNE
with a thick overcast sky steered to the N
under all sail at 10 AM sent up the fore
top gallant. Mast saw plenty of black fish
3 men to the mast head looking for whales
So ends this day Sat 9th 1894

Saturday June the 10th 1894 Days out 694
the forest the mid part light wind and
waved from every point of the compass
the latter part wind in force in gale from
the S & steered to the N under all sail
Commenced at 8 AM saw a large ship to the
land it steaming to the S & we have
been hanging to the top mast head
looking for whales and the ship is sailing
on her side seldom on her bottom
So ends this day

Sunday June the 11th 1894 Days out 695
all this day a heavy gale and it being
sea from the S. the ship under short
to the N took in the lower boat at 4 PM
So ends this day

Monday June the 12th 1894 Days out 696
this day strong winds from the S with
sea on it continued sea on it
So ends this day Sat 12th 1894

this day light wind from the SNE with squalls
of rain steered to the NNE given to the mast
head looking for whales we the vessel
sailing boats sending up royal yards
So ends this day

Wednesday June the 14th 1894 Days out 698
this day present weather at 6 PM shortened
sail at 4 PM saw sail steered to the NNE
we are imployed in repairing boats and
getting them ready for unloading which they
were knocked to pieces by bad weather when
on it look out for whales
So ends this day Sat 14th 1894

Thursday June the 15th 1894 Days out 699
this day present weather and light winds from
the S steered to the NNE at 4 PM shortened
sail at 4 PM saw sail at 4 PM saw 1 fin back
the watch imployed in repairing sail
So ends this day

Friday June the 16th 1894 Days out 700
this day present weather the watch imployed
in repairing sails wind from the S steered
to the NNE saw and shortened sail at 4 PM
saw several fin backs
So ends this day Sat 16th 1894

Saturday June the 17th 1894 Days out 701
this day present weather and light winds
and calm moderate shortened sail at 4 PM
saw several fin backs the watch imployed
in repairing sails
So ends this day
