

Sunday June the 18th 1894 Day out 648
this day first part of present weather mild
and later strong winds from the NW
and shortened sail to barely 1/2
at 11 am a large whale was seen & chased
and chased them returned to the ship at
11 without success while still in sight
So ends this day Lat 26° 15' Long 148° 15'

Monday June the 19th 1894 Day out 649
this day first part strong winds from
the S & NW and the landward land
got a large whale the ship did not
later part light winds and calm at
9 AM took the whale at long 149°
at 6 AM commenced cutting S
So ends this day Lat 26° 15'

Tuesday June the 20th 1894 Day out 644
this day first part implead with cutting
at 4 PM got them cutting and
began to hail this day ends with fine
weather and light winds
So ends this day

Wednesday June the 21st 1894 Day out 645
this day strong winds and plenty of
rain thunder and lightning we were implead
at hailing under short sail
So ends this day

Thursday June the 22nd 1894 Day out 646
this day light & wind but some rain and
a heavy tempest we were implead at
hailing under short sail So ends this day

Friday June the 23rd 1894 Day out 644
this day a heavy tempest with squalls of rain and it
thick overcast day at 5 PM got them hailing
So ends this day Lat 26° 15' Long 144° 30'

Saturday June the 24th 1894 Day out 648
this day pleasant weather at 6 AM saw a large
shale of whales land & water and chased
all day with out success the whale was
wild and March horse
So ends this day Lat 26° 15' Long 144° 15'

Sunday June the 25th 1894 Day out 649
this day pleasant weather and light winds
headed to the S under short sail saw a great
many whales tried to run star factory with
success So ends this day

Monday June the 26th 1894 Day out 650
this day squally weather we were implead with
strong rain under short sail saw several plain
hairs So ends this day

Tuesday June the 27th 1894 Day out 651
this day heavy squally weather. At 1 PM got
them strong rain and saw a whale to the S
of us at steering to the NW under short sail
So ends this day Lat 26° 15' Long 148° 15'

Wednesday June the 28th 1894 Day out 652
this day heavy squalls of rain and wind
wind was wrenched and play shortened
sail to 1/2 before required
So ends this day

Thursday June the 29th 1894 Day out 653
this day strong winds and squally weather
steered to the NW under short sail at 7 AM
saw a whale of the weather been
So ends this day

Friday June the 30th 1894 Day out 654
this day heavy squalls and raged weather and
shortened sail to barely
So ends this day
