this day at gail and heavy squalls of rain
heded to the N under a close reef
Main top sail
Ends this day

Saturday July the 2nd 1894 Days out 650
this day at gail from the S with it
being see lay by the wind heded to the ESE
under short sail a close reef Main top sail
Ends this day

Sunday July the 3rd 1894 Days out 654
this day the same as usual in the Country
at gail of wind from the S with it
the heavy see lay heded to the SE
at 4 pm ship to the N under a close
reef Main top sail at 4 pm took in the
Main top sail and hoisted
the other to the gail had it lashed
them so. Ends this day Sat 29th Long 144th

Tuesday July the 4th 1894 Days out 658
this day first part strong gales from the
S with it heavy see the S and SSW
part the wind moderated down and we had
sail fore sail and fore and Main top sail
the watch in blade with fitting the cutter
up tacks and pendant down several phis
hacks 9 men to the Mast had it looking
for wharves
Ends this day

Wednesday July the 5th 1894 Days out 659
this day present weather at 7 AM made
sail wind from the S very heavy phis
hacks
Ends this day Sat 29th Long 144th

Thursday July the 6th 1894 Days out 660
this day present weather at half past 12
made sail at 10 AM hail land 4 boats to the
starboard boat struck it whail and got stove
the most boat struck the two boats
at 4 pm took the whail at long side
shortened sail at 6 PM commenced at 11
at 11 got them cutting down surge phis
hacks so Ends this day Sat 29th Long 144th

Friday July the 7th 1894 Days out 661
this day present weather we are impleid boiling
under short sail heded to the E
Ends this day

Saturday July the 8th 1894 Days out 662
this day heavy squalls of rain and wind
with short driving we are impleid
boiling cold down several times in the
evening at 4 PM got them boiling
Ends this day

Sunday July the 9th 1894 Days out 669
this day at strong gail from the S with it heavy
see heded to the S with it more to the N
under short sail a close reef Main top sail
and fore topmast stay sail
Ends this day

Monday July the 10th 1894 Days out 664
this day at strong gail from the S with it heavy
perceived our need to be had we consider
did not hit to trust and we must get into some
port at quick parabol we consider that it
is best to go to Attagataha for safety at 11
at 11 put it way and steared ESE and made
sails sent out the fore top mast stay sail
and sent up the fore top yard and hoisted
the sail so Ends this day Sat 29th Long 144th
