

Remarks on board of the Ship *Palena*
Friday January the 7th 1842

First & middle part light winds from the
S.W. and equally rainy weather steering by the
wind to the South East. Employed at bracing out
the after hold for Provisions. Latter part nearly
calm
Latitude 33.10 South
Longitude 44.07 West

Saturday January the 8th
At all this day light winds or calm and pleasant
saw three sails at some distance
ed signals with a French Bark
Latitude 33.25 South
Longitude 44.27 West

Sunday January the 9th
First & middle part light winds from the N.W.
and pleasant weather steering S.W.
Latter part strong breezes from the N.W.
Latitude 33.38 South
Longitude 46.23 West

Monday January the 10th
First part strong breezes from N.W. Course S.W.
Middle part the wind from the W. & W. and
thick weather at 5 P.M. double reefed the top sail
Latter part light winds from the W. & W. made all
sail
Latitude 36.10 South
Longitude 47.56 West

Tuesday January the 11th
First part light winds and pleasant weather
from the Southward steering by the wind with
a heavy swell from the South, Middle &
Latter part light winds from the N.W.
Course S.W.
Latitude 37.54 South
Longitude 48.34 West

Captain R. Manchester Outward bound
Wednesday January 12th 1842

First part fresh winds from the N.W. & pleasant
weather Course S.W. by S. at 4 P.M. saw ship steering
S.W. Middle & Latter parts light winds or calm
Latitude 38.46 South
Longitude 51.21 West

Thursday January 13th
First part baffling winds or calm Course S.W. by S.
Middle part calm attended with heavy thunder
& lightning with heavy rain. Latter part fine breeze
from the S.E. sent down the mizzen topgallant
yard & mast
Latitude 39.47 South
Longitude 52.16 West

Friday January 14th
First part fresh breezes from the N.W. & pleasant
weather Course S.W. by S. Middle & Latter
part light winds from the S.W. at noon backed
to the west
Latitude 41.35 South
Longitude 53.29 West

Saturday January 15th
First part a fresh breeze from the South steering by
wind to the westward, Middle & Latter parts
variable winds or calm
Latitude 42.22 South
Longitude 55.53 West

Sunday January the 16th
First part strong winds from the N.W. West Course
S.W. by S. Middle part the wind from the N.W. by W.
at 1 P.M. double reefed the topsails. Latter part a
light wind from the W. & W. made all sail
steering by the wind to the Southward
Latitude 44.30 South
Longitude 57.33 West
