

Remarks on board of the Ship

Friday January the 28th

First part Strong winds from the NW and thick hazy weather heading W & W, at 1/2 past took in the main topgallant sail
Middle part blowing very hard from the WNW, at 2 P.M. lost the topsails furled the snigger topsail mainsail & fribb and reefed the fore sail, Latter part took in the fore topsail and set the spencers

Saturday January 29th

First part a fresh gale from the WNW with thick hazy weather heading to the S.W. at 3 P.M. were ship to the NW and made sail
Middle part a light wind and rainy weather from the NW, course W by S, made all sail, Latter part the wind hauled suddenly to the west and blew very hard: lost reefed the topsails reefed the fore sail and furled the mainsail & fribb heading N.W.

Sunday January 30th

First part a fresh gale from the westward and squally with rains stirring by the wind heading South by west under double reefed topsails and reefed main sail, Middle part Light winds from the E & S. course W by S Latter part a strong breeze from the S.E.

Monday January 31st

First part Strong breeze from the S.E. & S. with passing squalls of rain and hail let the reef out and set the main topgallant sail and fribb
Middle & Latter parts heavy squalls took in the main topgallant sail & fribb and double reefed the topsails the wind from the W & W. course W 1/2 South

Tuesday ~~January~~ February the 1st

First part a strong breeze from the South West attended with passing squalls of rain & hail heading S.W. let a reef out of the fore & main topsails & set the fribb, at 5 P.M. took in fribb & lost reefed the fore topsail and double reefed the main Middle part very squally Latter part more moderate let a reef out of the main topsail and set the fribb Latter by 6 P.M. 55.57 S

Wednesday February 2^d

First part a strong breeze from the W & W. attended with hazy weather at 4 P.M. tacked to the S.W. Middle & Latter part a strong wind from the S.W. at noon tacked to the S.E. & set the main topgallant sail

Thursday February 3^d

All this day strong winds & squally weather from the S.W. heading S.E. at 4 P.M. took in the fribb

Friday February 4th

First part strong wind from the W & W. attended with thick squally weather heading South at 4 P.M. lost reefed the fore & main & lost reefed the main topsails, Middle part blowing a gale from the west took in the fore sail fore and main topsails and set the fore & main spencers heading to the South

Saturday February 5th

All this day a strong gale from the South West attended with thick weather heading to the South at half past 5 P.M. were ship to Westward
