

Remarks on board of the ship
Sunday February the 6th AD 1842.

First part light winds from the S.W. attended
with passing squalls of rain steering by the wind
W.V.W. Middle part strong winds and squally
at S.W. took in the main topgallant sail
and double reefed the top sail. Latter part much
the same filled the fidd. Lat by Obs 53.35 S
Long by Ch^r 79.23 W

Monday February 7th

All this day a strong breeze from the west attended
with squally weather steering by the wind to the
N.W. Latter part backed ship. Lat by Obs 53.50
Long by Ch^r 79.44

Tuesday February 8th

First part strong winds from the west and
cloudy heading S.W. at 12 part 4 R. backed to
the S.W. Middle & Latter part heavy squally
of hail & rain close reefed the topsails. Dried
the fidd & main sail wind S.W. Course S.W.
Lat by Obs 52.26 S
Long by Ch^r 79.35 W

Wednesday February 9th

First & middle part a strong winds and
heavy squally of hail. Latter part fresh breeze
& pleasant weather, Course S.W. wind S.W.
Lat by Obs 48.13 S
Long by Ch^r 81.15 W

Thursday February 10th

First part light winds from South and
pleasant weather, Course S.W. Middle &
Latter part light squally of rain.
Lat by Obs 46.27 S
Long by Ch^r 81.15 W

Friday February 11th

First part a strong breeze from the South
and cloudy weather, Course S.W. Middle
part the same, Latter part strong winds from
the west & squally Lat by Obs 43.32 S
Long by Ch^r 80.35 W

Saturday February 12th

First part a strong wind from the west
attended with squally weather, Course S.W.
took in the mainsail & fidd & double reefed
the topsails. Middle part light squally of
rain. Latter part light winds & cloudy
made all sail employed at putting the spars
over the stern and fitting the quarter boat.
Lat by Obs 46.53 South
Long by Ch^r 80.11 West

Sunday February 13th

All this day light winds from the S.W. and
cloudy weather, steering by the wind to the S.W.
Employed at raising the masts & the rigging.
Lat by Obs 46.14 South
Long by Ch^r 78.36 West

Monday February 14th

All this day a light breeze from the North-east
and fine weather steering by the wind to the
N.E. Employed at sending up the mizen topgallant
mast & yards. Lat by Obs 38.09 South
Long by Ch^r 77.52 West

Tuesday February 15th

All this day light breeze from the west and
pleasant weather steering by the wind to the S.W.
Pace grassmuzzes. Lat by Obs 38.04 South
Long by Ch^r 77.54 West
