

Remarks on board of the Ship

Wednesday March the 9th

All this day strong trades attended with cloudy weather. Steady NW. until 8 AM then WNW

Lat by Obs 82.43 S
Long by Chy 81.33 W

Thursday the 10th

All this day light trades & pleasant weather steering to the N.W. Westward

Lat by Obs 82.00 S
Long by Chy 82.52 W

Friday the 11th

All this day light trades & pleasant weather steering to the N.E. saw the land

Lat by Obs 81.35 S
Long by Chy 81.33 W

Saturday the 12th

First part light trades and pleasant weather steering N by E, at sundown took in sail, Middle & Latter part calm at 7 Bell spoke the Ship's Boat Capt. Mrazakinski & dandy 27 months out with 5.50 barrels of oil bound to Payta Sand in sight

Sunday the 13th

First part fresh trades and pleasant steering (8 by 3) at 8 Bell took in the topgallant sail. Payta Head bearing East 15 miles dist. Middle & Latter part light winds. at 11 AM came to anchor at Payta found the ship's Catherine of Saint at anchor 34 months out with 700 barrels of oil

Monday March the 14th

All this day pleasant weather employed on Liberty. At noon the Boat came to anchor employed at painting ship

Tuesday the 15th

All this day pleasant weather employed at painting ship on watch on Liberty

Wednesday the 16th

All this day pleasant weather employed at painting ship and getting off potatoes on watch on Liberty

Thursday the 17th

All this day pleasant weather employed at painting and getting off potatoes on watch on Liberty

Friday the 18th

All this day pleasant weather employed at getting off potatoes. At 11 AM the ship's Boat Mitchell of Saint came to anchor 69 months out with 230 barrels of oil

Saturday the 19th

All this day light breezes & pleasant weather. At 4 AM took our anchor and went to sea 2 ships & a steaming boat in sight
