Wednesday June 7th 1843

All this day strong winds from the
N.E. & Cloudy steering by the wind to
the S.E. at sun set wore ship to
the N.W. & took in the fore sail, fore &
mizen top sails, at sun rise wore ship
to the Eastward set the fore sail &
fore top sail No observations this day

Thursday 8th
All this day strong breeze & cloudy, wind
from the Northward steering by the wind
to the Eastward saw fin backs

Friday 9th
First part light wind from the North
& pleasant weather steering to the East
Middle & Latter part wind from the S.W.
& cloudy steering N.E. by S. Employed at
pulling the fore rigging

Saturday 10th
First & Middle parts fine breezes &
cloudy from the S.W. steering N.E. Latter
part wind from the N.E. steering by the
wind heading E.S.E. finished pulling the
fore rigging saw fin backs porpoises & swordfish

First & middle parts light winds & cloudy
wind from the Eastward steering by the wind
Latter part wind from the N.E. & foggy

Long by Chio 153.15, E

Monday June 12th AD 1843
All this day fresh breezes from the Northward
& cloudy steering E by N. at 12 A.M. spoke
the ship Lilla Rokk of N.B. 32, 1600

Tuesday 13th
Strong winds & cloudy steering to the
N.W. saw sperm whales lowered the
boats 3 times but they were going so fast
to the windward we could not catch them
Lat by obs 31.28, N



Wednesday 14th
All this day fresh wind & cloudy steering
to the S.W. saw sperm whales
Lat by obs 31.33, N



Thursday 15th
All this day fine weather wind from the S.W.
at 4 P.M. saw a school of whales lowered the
boats could not catch them they were going
quick to the windward at 8 A.M. saw 2 more
lowered & at 10 took one along side

All this day fine weather, at 6 P.M.
finished cutting, Latter part commenced
boiling
