

Remarks on board of ship

Sunday June 18th 1843
First part heavy gales & cloudy, at 2³⁰ PM
more moderate began to boil latter part
fine weather
Lat
Long

Monday 19th
All this day fine weather, at 10 PM
finished boiling, latter part boisterous, saw
2 ships to the eastward
Lat
Long

Tuesday 20th
All this day fine weather steering to the
south finished boiling at 5 PM saw a
large body of whales going quick to the
windward lower the boat without success
Lat by obs 31.10. N
Long by chron 155.30 E

Wednesday 21st
All this day fine breeze & thick weather,
employed at stowing down oil in the
main hold, at 5 PM saw 3 sperm whales
lowered without success saw the Lalla
Rookh
Lat by obs 31.30. N
Long by chron 156.00 E

Thursday 22^d
All this day strong winds & cloudy weather
wind from the S.W. the Lalla Rookh in sight
Lat by obs 31.47. N
Long by chron 156.06 E

Baleena Captain R Manchester

Friday June 23^d 1843
All this day strong gales & thick weather
wind S.W. the Lalla Rookh in sight
No obs this day

Saturday 24th
First part strong gales & rainy from
the S.W. standing to the S.E. under Red sail
the Lalla Rookh in sight, at 10 PM set
took in the fore & mizzen top sails &
fore sail & wore ship to the westward
Middle part moderate latter part
light winds & thick weather 2 ships in sight
Lat by obs 31.06. N
Long by chron 156.08 E

Sunday 25th
First part light winds & thick weather
steering to the S.E. at 4 PM spoke the ship
Mt. Vernon of Nant 44 months out 2350 lbs
& the Lalla Rookh, at 10 PM set double reefed
middle & latter part strong winds & very rough
sea saw 2 sails to the S.W. latter part steering
by the wind to the N.W.
Lat by obs 31.20. N
Long by chron 155.40 E

Monday 26th
First part strong wind & cloudy with a
very rough sea raining, steering by the wind
to the N.W. Middle & latter parts steering
to the south saw a ship to the north
saw Fin backs
Lat
Long

Tuesday 27th
All this day strong winds & thick rainy
weather wind from the westward saw 2
ships to the north saw nothing but
Fin back
No obs this day
