& thick weather, wind N.E. Latter part
pleasant weather steering to the Eastward
Lat by obs 31° 5' N
Long by obs 154° 00' E

Thursday 29th
All this day fresh breezes from the N.E. &
pleasant weather saw nothing of the whale
kind

Lat by obs 31° 10' N

Long 154° 30' E

All this day moderate breezes & cloudy
wind from the Eastward saw nothing
of the whale kind Latter part saw
a bark to the North

Lat by obs 31° 40' N

Friday July 1st
All this day strong winds from the Northward
with a plenty of rain steering to the S.E.
saw nothing of the whale kind

Saturday 2nd
First and middle parts equally with a
plenty of rain Latter part light winds
from the S.W. & cloudy steering to the
S.E. saw nothing of the whale kind
Lat by obs 31° 06' N

Ship Balena July 1843

Monday July 3rd
All this day squally rainy weather
steering to the Eastward saw a ship
steering to the North supposed her
to be the Sallow Hook, saw fin backs
& porpoises No observations this day

Tuesday 4th
All this day strong winds from the S.E.
& thick weather steering to the Eastward
Lat by obs 31° 12' N
Long by obs 159° 44' E

Wednesday 5th
All this day strong winds & thick
weather steering to the Eastward
at 3 P.M. saw a ship 22 miles
but with a squall, tracked ship at noon
No obs this day

Thursday 6th
All this day strong winds & thick weather
steering to the Westward saw nothing
of the whale kind
Lat by obs 30° 50' N
Long by obs 157° 32' E

Friday 7th
All this day moderate breezes & thick
rainy weather steering West. saw killers
porpoises & squid Lat by obs 31° 12' N
Long by obs 156° 03' E
