Saturday July 29th
All this day fine breeze from the
Eastward, set the sails at the leeward
to Coiling, At 11 AM Spoke the ship
La Lagartera 5 minutes out with 100 lbs
Lat by obs 29° 35' N
Long "

Sunday 30th
All this day fine weather steering to
the SE Eastward, saw 2 ships to the
windward showing a white signal
with a black cross in it. Saw nothing
of the whale kind
Lat by obs 29° 01'

Monday 31st
All this day light air or calm
saw a large brack to the windward
Lat by obs 29° 32' N

Tuesday August 1st
All this day light air or calm
Saw nothing but grampuses & squid
Lat by obs 29° 41' N
Long " Choo 158° 13' E

Wednesday 2^d
All this day light air or calm
Steering to the Eastward saw nothing
but grampuses
Lat by obs 30° 00'

Thursday 3^d
First part Calm saw a large
brack to the South Middle part baff
winds Latter part light breeze from the SE
& pleasant Steering SE or E
Lat by obs 30° 12'

Ship Salama Aug 1843
Friday August 4th
All this day fine breeze from the SW
& pleasant Steering to the Eastward
Saw 2 ships 1 of them is sailing
Lat by obs 30° 25' N
Long " Choo 160° 43' E

Saturday 5th
All this day fresh breeze from
the South with light squalls of rain
steering to the Eastward
Saw nothing of the whale kind
Lat by obs 29° 59' N

Sunday 6th
All this day strong winds from
the South & cloudy steering to
the Eastward, saw nothing of the
whale kind
Lat by obs 29° 40' N
Long " Choo 165° 02' E

Monday 7th
All this day squally weather wind
from the South steering to the East
Saw nothing of the whale kind
Lat by obs 29° 57' N

Tuesday 8th
All this day strong winds from
the South and cloudy steering
East, saw nothing of the whale
kind
Lat by obs 29° 41' N
Long " Choo 165° 12' E

Wednesday 9th
All this day strong winds & cloudy
steering to the Eastward saw a bark
steering to the East, wind South
Lat
Long
