Thursday 14th
All this day fine weather Employed
at boiling saw 3 ships

Lat by obs 30.40
Long by Chron 174.00

Friday 15th
All this day fine weather steering
to the Eastward 2 ships in sight
at 10 PM finished boiling & began
to Cooper for Stowing down

Saturday 16th
All this day fine weather Employed
at Stowing down in the after hold
2 ships in sight

Sunday 17th
All this day light winds & pleasant
Employed at Stowing down oil in
the after hold saw 2 ships
Lat by obs 30 17 N
Long by Chron 174.54 E

Monday 18th
All this day light winds & pleasant
weather steering to S E finished Stowing
down. At 12 PM set spoke the ship
Alexander Coffin of about 35 months out
with 1900 lbs of sperm oil
Latter part repairing the main sail.

Tuesday 19th
All this day light winds from
the S W & pleasant steering to
the Eastward 2 ships in sight
Lat by obs 29.20 N
Long by Chron 174.24 E

Wednesday 20th
All this day light winds from
the South & pleasant weather saw
3 ships, steering to the Eastward.
Lat by obs 29.00 N
Long by Chron 174.54 E

Thursday 21st
First & middle parts light winds or
calm, latter part light squalls with
rain from the East steering by the wind
to the South
Lat by obs 28.14 N
Long by Chron 176.58 E

WB 25 Friday 22nd
Light winds from the S E or calm
steering to the S E at 2 PM saw
a school of small whales over the
boats at 5 took one of them along
side, latter part strong winds from the
S & pleasant. at 10 AM finished cutting
Lat by obs 28.17 N

Saturday 23rd
Strong winds & squally with rain
Employed at boiling steering to the
Eastward saw 1 ship

Sunday 24th
All this day strong winds & squally
from S W steering S E by E finished
boiling turned up 33 oil
Lat by obs 28.43 N
Long by Chron 178.20 E
