

Remarks on board of the ship

Monday Oct 23rd 1843

All this day light breezes & pleasant weather steering by the wind to the NE saw a ship steering down the Land. At 10 AM saw a shoal of small whales toward the boats and gave chase Land in sight



Tuesday 24th

First part light breezes from the East the boats in chase of whales at 4 came on board without success the whales very shy. Middle & Latter parts steering by the wind heading NNE. Employed at repairing the boats

All this day strong winds from the East with squally weather steering by the wind heading NNE. Saw 4 whales

All this day baffling winds from the East steering by the wind to the North

All this day baffling winds from the Eastward steering by the wind to the Northward

First part light baffling winds from the Eastward steering to the Northward Middle and Latter parts fine breeze from the SW Course ENE

Monday October 29th

First part fine breeze from the SW steering ENE with all drawing sail set. Middle & Latter parts squally with rain

Tuesday 30th

First part strong winds from the SW steering ENE with all drawing sail set. Middle & Latter parts light breeze from the ENE. Latter part calm

Lat by Obs 28.29. N Long by Obs 147.16. W

Wednesday 31st

First part calm & clear weather. Employed at ridding down the mast rigging Middle & Latter parts light air from the East steering to the North.

Lat by Obs 28.37

Thursday 2nd

All this day baffling winds from the North to East. Calm steering to the Eastward. Employed at painting boats

Lat by Obs 28.55. N Long by Obs 147.28. W

Friday 3rd

All this day baffling winds from the NNE & pleasant weather steering by the wind to the Northward
