Monday 27th
All this day light baffling winds
from the N.E. or calm steering E by S
saw black fish porpoises & the Land in
sight bearing North. Lat by Obs 23.16.00
Long by Chron 108.28.00

Tuesday 28th
All this day baffling winds of calm
steering to the Eastward. Saw a ship to the
westward. Lat by Obs 23.02.00
Long by Chron 108.28.00

Wednesday 29th
First part calm North, & rough sea
on, Middle & Latter part fine breezes
from the Northward & Cloudy steering
E by S and E by S saw fin backs
Lat by Obs 21.04.00
Long by Chron 107.37.00

Thursday 30th
All this day fine breezes from the North
& Cloudy steering E by S. Latter part Land
in sight. Lat by Obs 20.06.00
Long by Chron 105.36.00

Friday Dec 1st
First & Middle part fine breezes from
the North & pleasant steering E by S
Latter part squally with rain. Land
at noon 10 miles dist. Lat by Obs 18.10.00
Long by Chron 105.13.00

Saturday Dec 2nd 1843
First part light winds from the S. or calm,
Middle part light winds from the North
steering S by E, Latter part wind S by E and squally
with rain, Land in sight dist 20 miles

Sunday 3rd
First part heavy squall with rain from the
S by heading to the South furled the top
sails & set sail, 1st & 2nd spanker, Middle part lying
to under Mainmast and H.M. stay sail
Latter part squally with rain set the top
sails double reefed & fore sail & so on

Monday 4th
First part baffling winds with squalls of rain
steering to the South, Middle part heavy squalls
from the N.E., Latter part light winds &
cloudy. Lat by Obs 16.40.00
Long by Chron 105.33.00

Tuesday 5th
First part calm & cloudy, Middle part light
air from the E. Latter part fine breezes from
N.E. & pleasant weather, Employed at repairing
the main sail saw porpoises
Lat by Obs 16.40.00
Long by Chron 105.33.00

Wednesday 6th
All this day light baffling winds &
pleasant steering S by E, Employed at repair-
ing sails. Lat by Obs 15.28.00

Thursday 7th
First part light winds and pleasant
weather steering S by E, Middle & Latter
part heavy squalls with rain from all
round the compass. Lat by Obs 14.17.00
