All this day fine weather at 5 P.M. finished cutting & commenced boiling again saw a plenty of porpoises
Sat by 05 00 40, S

Saturday 13th

All this day light winds & pleasant weather employed at boiling
Sat by 05 20 S

Sunday 14th

All this day fine breezes & pleasant weather at 10 P.M. finished boiling turned up 133 3/4 2 ships in sight
Sat by 05 00 30 S

Monday 15th

All this day light winds & pleasant weather, let to 20 1/2 Speke ships Crew of 39 months but 15 10 3/4 Sperm & Canton of A B 4 months but 14.00 whale & 400 Sperm, Latter part Coopering Oil
Sat by 05 00 08 S

Tuesday 16th

All this day fine breezes & pleasant weather employed at Coopering & baking out to Stow Horn Oil No. 05

Wednesday 17th

All this day fresh breezes & pleasant weather employed at Stowing down Oil in the after hold
Sat by 05 1 3/4 P

Monday 22nd

All this day strong winds & pleasant weather, saw nothing of the whale kind
Sat by 05 00 28 P
Long " thro 135.08 S

Tuesday 23rd

First & middle parts moderate breezes Latter part strong winds & pleasant weather, saw nothing of the whale kind
Sat by 05 0 28 S
Long " thro 135.3 S

All this day fine breezes & pleasant weather hearing by E, saw Porpoises
