All this day fresh breezes & thick smoky weather; at 12 past 1 PM saw a shoal of sperm whales going quick to the windward lowering the boat without success. Employed at repairing sails. Lat by obs 24.45

First part strong breezes & thick smoky weather, Middle & Latter part light winds & smoky steering to the south. Lat by obs 22.50.5

First part light winds & pleasant weather steering NW; at sundown took in sails & heaved by the wind heaving to the North, at 7 AM saw Jarvis Island. Lat by obs 00.32.9
