Saturday May the 4th 1844

All this day light winds & pleasant weather, Steering to the N.W. with all sail out
Lat by Obs 1.43. N
Long " Chro. 168. 02.8

Sunday 5th

All this day fresh breeze & Squally weather Steering N.W. by W. with all sail out. Saw Porpoises
Lat 3.03. N
Long 166. 45.6

Monday 6th

All this day baffling winds & Squally rainy weather, Steering W. by N. with all sail out
Lat by Obs

Tuesday 7th

All this day Strong winds & Cloudy Squally weather with rain Steering W. by N. W. with all sail out
Lat by Obs 4.54. N
Long " Chro 163. 46. 0

Wednesday 8th

All this day Strong winds & Squally with rain, at 4 P.M. saw Strong Island bearing N. by E. at sunset took in sail latter part Steering for the land

Thursday 9th

Strong winds with squalls of rain at 11 AM the Capt went on shore to look for woods, Middle part going off and on vice versa. Sail latter part 3 Sails on shore for wood on the South side of the Island

Balaena bound towards Japan

Friday May the 10th 1844

Squally, with some rain, going off and on on the South side of Strong Is 3 Sails after woods, got off 1 Boat load.

Saturday 11th

First & Middle parts pleasant weather Latter part Strong winds & Squally some rain Steering N.W.

Sunday 12th

All this day Strong winds & Squally with rain, Steering to the N.W. with all sail out

Monday 13th

All this day Strong winds with heavy squalls of rain Steering N.W.

Tuesday 14th

All this day Strong winds & Squally with rain Steering W. by N. with all sail out at 1 PM took in sail & lay aback until day light latter part Steering N.W. with all sail out

Wednesday 15th

All this day Squally with rain Steering N.W. with all sail out Lat by Obs 4. 25

Thursday 16th

Strong winds some squally Steering N.W. with all sail out Lat by Obs 5. 15. N

Friday 17th

All this day moderate breeze & Cloudy weather, Steering N by W with all sail
Lat by Obs 12. 57. N
Long " Chro 158. 11. 0
