Wednesday July 25th 1844

First part Light breeze & pleasant weather
3 Ships in sight. Middle & latter part
Strong gales and thick cloudy weather
Lat by obs 29.18.25
Long 168.12

Thursday 26th

First part light winds & pleasant
weather, middle and latter part light
winds & foggy, latter part fine breeze & mod-
erate breeze & pleasant weather
Lat by obs 29.35
Long 168.11

Friday 27th

First part light breeze & pleasant weather
Middle & latter part strong breeze & thick
cloudy weather. Saw 2 Ships
Lat by obs 30.00
Long 168.11

Saturday 28th

First part thick weather, middle and
latter part light breeze & pleasant weather
Saw 3 Ships

Sunday 30th

First part calm spoke the Ship Zephyr
of NB 13 months. 400 Sperm latter part
light breeze from SE steering to the W
3 Ships in sight
Lat
Long

Monday July 1st

All this day fine weather wind
south, at 8 P.M. spoke the Young Eagle
of Nant 7 months out 150 Blk Sperm
at 6 A.M. part of shoal of whales
lowered the boats and caught
one of them at 9 commenced
cutting.

Long 168.11

All this Tuesday July 24th 1844
fine weather, at 3 P.M. finished
cutting and commenced boiling. Saw 2 Ships
Lat by obs 29.50
Long 168.12

Wednesday 31st

First part strong breeze & smoky weather
Middle and latter part thick rainy weather
at 1 A.M. finished boiling turned up 53 blb
Lat by obs 30.00
Long 168.12

Thursday 1st

First and middle part light winds
and thick cloudy weather, latter part
strong breeze & rainy, exposed part of the oil
for stowing. Spoke the Bark Canton, Lees of NB
32 months out 1300 Sperm. Lat by obs
Long 168.12

Friday 5th

First and middle part light winds &
cloudy in company with the Bark Canton
latter part strong breeze oil stored 34.116
between decks
Lat by obs 30.31.18

Saturday 6th

First and middle part light breeze &
pleasant weather, stored off the fore part
Spoke Ship Hecate of NB 22 months out
700 Sperm. latter part foggy Lat by obs 30.51.18
Long 167.19.18

Sunday 7th

All this day fine weather, at 8 P.M. saw
Sperm whale toward the boat and gave chase
2 Ships in sight among the whales
Spoke Ship Hope 6 months out Lat by obs 30.42.18

Monday 8th

All this day fine weather the boats
off after whales, at 6 came on boards
without success whales very shy
latter part saw a Ship a Whaling
Lat 30.00
Long 167.30
