Wednesday July 24th 1846
Fine weather; saw fin backs & Porpoises
Lat by obs 30.00, N
Long. Chs 170.23, E

Thursday 25th
Light winds or calms, saw nothing
of the whale king Lat by obs 30.38, N

Friday 26th
Light winds or calms, saw fin backs
& Grampuses Lat 29.45, N

Saturday 27th
First part light winds and pleasant
weather, latter part strong winds & cloudy
Lat by obs 31.12, N

Sunday 28th
First part light winds & pleasant,
Spoke the Ship Jersey off N.B. latter
part squally with rain Lat.

Monday 29th
First part squally, latter part fine
weather, saw fin backs 3 Ships in sight
Lat by obs 31.15, N
Long Chs 171.38, E

Tuesday 30th
First part light breeze & pleasant
weather & Ships in sight latter part
baffling winds & squally Lat 29.44, N

Wednesday 31st
All this day fine weather, Spoke the
Ship West of Falmouth 33 months
out 1400 lbs, saw plenty fin backs
Lat by obs 30.50, N
Long Chs 172.55, E

Ship Balena, Capt R. Mendenhall
Thursday August the 1st 1846
All this day light winds and pleasant
weather, saw many fin backs Lat by obs 30.50, N

Friday 2^d
All this day baffling winds and some
squally, at 6 A.M. saw sperm whales
lowered the boats and gave chase
3 Ships in sight N.B. Obs

Saturday 3^d
All this day baffling winds & squally
at 4 P.M. the Boat came on board
without success the whale had a line
fast to him, latter part saw the
Herc of Nant taking a whale, Lat 30.50, N
Long 171.39

Sunday 4th
All this day strong winds & cloudy weather
saw a Hark to the westward
Lat by obs 31.00, N

Monday 5th
First part strong breeze and pleasant
weather, at 10 A.M. started 500 sperm
and 80 whale, latter part strong winds
& cloudy, saw nothing of the whale
kind Lat by obs 31.15, N
Long Chs 174.17, E

Tuesday 6th
All this day strong winds and pleasant
weather, at 6 A.M. started to the S.E.
Lat by obs 31.41, N
Long Chs 176.47

Wednesday 7th
All this day strong winds and cloudy
weather. Steered to the S.E.

Thursday 8th
All this day heavy squally weather
at 9 P.M. took in the main top sail
& fore sail, saw a Ship standing to the
North, latter part to the main top sail
& fore sail Lat by obs 29.56, N
