

Remarks on board of the Ship

Friday, March 7<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours strong gales and squally from the N.W. with some rain. Course S by E. Lat by Obs. 44. 35 S, long. by Ch. 83. 18. W. D.R. 44. 35. " " D.R. 83. 20 W. Variation 1/2 point E. Easterly.

Saturday, March 8<sup>th</sup> First part strong gales from the N.W. and cloudy, middle part moderate breeze and squally, latter part strong gales with fresh squalls of rain. Course S S E. Lat by Obs. 46. 41. S. Variation 1 3/4 points E. " " D.R. 46. 48. " " long " " 83. 20 W.

Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours strong gales with heavy squalls of rain from the W.N.W. Course S S E. At noon took in the fore sail and main top sails wind from the West. Lat by Obs. 49. 00. S. Variation 1 3/4 points E. " " D.R. 49. 04. " " long " " 83. 00. W.

Monday 10<sup>th</sup> First part heavy squalls from W. laying too under fore & main spencers, at 4 P.M. set the main top sail and fore sail. Middle part heavy squalls, latter part much the same. Lat by Obs. 50. 37. S. Course S S E. " " D.R. 50. 32. " " Variation 2 points E. long " Chro 82. 47. W. " " D.R. 82. 50. "

Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> First part of these 24 hours strong winds with heavy squalls from the N.W. by W. took in the fore & mizzen top sails. Course, S E by S. Middle and latter parts more moderate set the top sails. Variation 2 points E. Lat by Obs. 52. 31. S. " " D.R. 52. 28. S. " " long " D.R. 82. 47. W.

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Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> First part strong gales and clear, winds from the westward. Middle part light winds and rainy, latter part light winds from the north and cloudy. Course S E. Variation 2 points E. Lat by Obs. 53. 42. S. Long. D.R. 80. 05. W.

Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> First part light winds and cloudy from N to W. middle part fine breeze and rainy. Course S E. latter part fresh gales and cloudy. Course S E by E. 2 1/4 points Variation E. Lat by Obs. 55. 28. S. D.R. 55. 20. " " long " D.R. 79. 29. W.

Friday 14<sup>th</sup> First part strong gales from the N.W. and cloudy. Course S E by E. middle part clear course S E. latter part pleasant breeze and fine weather. Course E by S. Lat by Obs. 56. 58. S. Variation 2 1/4 points " D.R. 57. 07. " " long " D.R. 75. 32. W.

Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> First and middle pleasant breezes and fine weather from the North west. Course S E. latter part wind haul led to the N.E. and cloudy. Steering by the wind to the S E. Lat by Obs. 57. 24. S. Variation 2 1/4 points E. " " D.R. 57. 29. " " long " D.R. 72. 08.

Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> All these 24 hours light winds from the N.E. and passing clouds. Steering by the winds to the Eastward. Spoke the bark Golconda of Swansea England bound to Valparaiso. Lat by Obs. 58. 14. S. D.R. 58. 08. " " long " " 70 10. W. Variation 2 1/4 points E.
