Saw White Whales and porpoises the Water took green all hands Employed selling up Rigging and fitting a mizen stay day ends with strong gales from S.W. which brought us under Double Reefed Top Sails, Jib & Spinnaker in Lat obs 40° 43' South	Friday 30th 8th out	1831 through the day heavy gales from S.W. laying by under main top sail and fore top mast stay sail latter part more moderate Set the fore sail fore and mizen top sail Steering to the S.W. Lat obs 44° 02' South	Saturday 31st 8th out	Begins with strong gales from S.W. Steering S.W. Sent down the fore and mizen top gallant jib and masts and got in the flying jibboom at 8 P.M. wore ship to the South Wind W.S.W. at 10 A.M. tacked to the S.W. Employed in Calking the deck Lat obs 43° 00' South	Sunday 1st Jan 8th out	1832 Begins with pleasant weather Wind W.S.W. Steering S.W.
