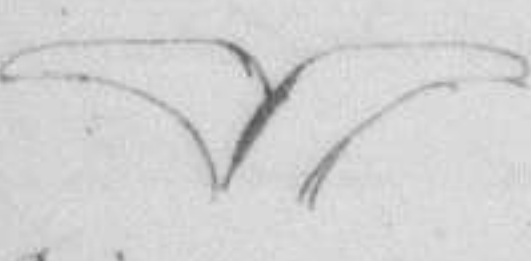

begins Sunday 15th Lead out 99°	begins with fine weather Wind at North Steering S.W. Saw fine backs and porpoises through the night strong breezes from North at day light saw Cape Horn at the same time saw a brig latter part light airs from E.N.E. Steering S.W. by W Lat 56° 18' Cape Horn bearing by Compass North Variation 24° E	Wednesday 18th 103° out	begins with fine breezes from S.W. Weather thick Steering West by Compass Saw porpoises at 8 P.M. it blew a gale Close Reefs the top sails & took in jib, spanker and main sail latter part more moderate Foggy Rainy Cold disagreeable weather and head winds Wind N.W. S. & obs
Monday 16th 100° out Sent off Four to 9th mass out the 11th p.m. Lydon	begins with fine weather Wind from E.N.E.
