Friday 25 th 228 ^d out	through the day thick cloudy weather with some rain Wind from N N E to N W steering to the Eastward Lat obs 31-43 N
Sat 26 th 228 ^d out	Begins with cloudy weather Wind N N E steering to the East toward the night raining hard past passed day ends calm with heavy sea from South Lat obs 31-44 N Long by Chronometer 178-24
Sunday 27 th 227 ^d out	Begins with calm with heavy sea from South at 6 P M heavy rains heading to the N E - later part strong breezes from S W steering N by E Lat obs 32-32 N Long at 4 A M 177-42 W Long at 3 P M 177-04 W
Monday 28 th 228 ^d out	Begins with strong gails with showers of rain from S W steering N E three the night heavy by head to S E Wind S W Lat obs 32-22 N Long 176-30 W
Tuesday 29 th 229 ^d out	1882 Begins with light breezes from W S W steering to the South No signs of whales here and there to go after them I no not Day ends with fine weather Wind N N W steering West Lat obs 32-00 N Long at 4 P M 176-54 W
Wednesday 30 th 230 ^d out	Begins with fine weather wind steering to the W S W Employed in taking down the tryworks and building them up as they work bad to much draft day ends with thick weather Lat obs 32-14 N
Thursday 31 st 231 ^d out	Begins with thick weather and some rain had great quantity of Right whale food at what High mail men call Bret had porpoises & blackfish Lat obs 33-14 North Long by Chron 177-38 W
Friday 1 June 231 ^d out	Begins with light airs from W S W steering to the South at 4 P M we ship to the N W day ends with fine breezes from S W Long at 4 P M 178-32 W
Sat 2 ^d	Begins with cloudy weather Wind at South at 6 P M had several Right Whales and great numbers of fin backs day ends with a gail from South No obs
