Lored 3 Boats Make 3 miles
to Windward Ship magnet. also
Lored in Company
my Boats fastened to one large one
and Lost him by the line Parting
after being fast one hour
magnet got one
Lat obs 29° 12' North

Monday
23rd

80 lbs

Begins with fine weather
Wind S E at 6 A m Saw
a Large Whale going to W m
Lored in Chair of him
at 9 A m fastened & killed him
at 10 he got him long side
at 11 began to cut
No obs

Tuesday
24th

through the day fine weather
Employed Cutting at 4 P m
finished the Baddy and began
to Bail Lay by the head
through the Night
Latter part Employed
bailing Cais & Bailing
Ship magnet & one more ship
in sight
Lat obs 29° 35' North

Wednesday
25th

W

at 7 A m Saw Whales
Lored all the Boats with out
except grate numbers of Whales
in sight but very small
No obs

Thursday
26th

WB
25 lbs

1832
Begins with fine weather
Wind S E & Sails in sight but will
Lored all the Boats with
out except 40 or 50 barrels
Dulls at 7 P m Lored all
the Boats and fastened to 3
or 4 barrel Dulls lost 2 of them
it being tight and they
Running to Windward
Dook the other to Ship
thru the Night lay by the
Whale one Ship to Windward Bailing
at 8 A m began to cut
at 9 finished bailing and made
Sail to the South
Saw a Sail to Leeward
Lat obs 29° 48' North
Long by Chronom 4 P m 17000 E

Friday
27th

Begins with fine weather
Wind S E & Sails in sight
Employed Bailing
Saw grate numbers of Jumpers
2 Sails to Leeward
at 10 A m finished Bailing
Lat obs 29° 00' North

Saturday
28th

Begins with strong breeze
from East steering to S E
Saw 2 Sails to Windward
day ends with strong gails
Lat obs 29° 14' N

Sunday
29th

through the day strong gails
from S E & Sails in sight
Lored Receipt top sails
Lat obs 28° 40' N
