at 2 P M. Saw a Shag of Sperm
Whales at 3 so Loped 3 Boats &

ones at 8 P M got them fast

day Ends Bailing Lat 28° 43' N

Through the day Squally
at 9 A M Saw a Sperm Whale
going to W SW tacked to West
after him finished Bailing at
meridian Lat 28° 50' N
