24th

from East Employed
Boiling at 11 PM finished
boiling Day Ends in Lat
28 29 N 10th

Tuesday
25th
Through the day squally
with showers of Rain
Winds from E & S
N 28 29

Wednesday
26th
Begins with Squally weather
Wind variable
B men Sick of duty
better part fine weather
Lat 28 29 N 10th
Long Chronometer 133-12 m

Thursday
27th
Begins with fine weather
Wind S of S blowing
by Sea & saw numbers of
Birds & small fish
but Whales none
