Sunday 27th Begins with Squally weather Wind from S.E. to S.W. Steady to S.W. Lat Obs 24° 12' N

Monday 28th Begins with Squally weather Wind East Lat 1 A.M. Saw 3 sperm whales Lured and killed 3 took them to ship Lat Obs 1° 36' N

Tuesday 29th Through the day nothing Remarkable On board Bailing and Storing down oil Lat Obs 49 miles North

Wednesday 30th Begins with fine weather On board Bailing and Storing down oil at 1 A.M. finished bailing Lat Obs 47 miles South Long by Lunar 126° 54'

Thursday 31st Through the day Wind S.W. Steady to the S.W. On board Storing down oil Lat Obs 9 miles North

Friday 1st Begins with fine weather Wind S.W. Steady S.W. On board Storing down oil Lat Obs 1° 24' N

Sat 2 Begins with fine weather Wind S.W. Steady S.W. Found 2 had 24 Casks of Bread On Board Lat Obs 2° 54' North

Sunday 3 Through the day Nothing Remarkable Lat Obs

Monday 4 Through the day nothing Remarkable Lat Obs 12 1/2 N

Tuesday 5 Through the day fine weather Wind S.W. Steady South On board Repairing Starboard Boat Lat Obs 36 miles North

Wednesday 6 all day fine weather Steady South Lat Obs 54 miles South

Thursday 7 Through the day fine weather Steady to S.W. Wind S.W. Lat Obs 14 miles North
