except now and then a small
shower of rain
None of the crew sick
and by Whales make me
stead for the Sandwich Isls

Tuesday 23 April Begons with fine Breeze
from N. C. and Wind Islands
as fast as possible if
no Whales intervene
and here seems small
prospect of them at present
I believe all things are
fixed by the Will of God
unalterable
Day ends with Pleasant weather
and light Breeze from N. C.
Lat 88 12 24 N
Long by Chronometer 141 48

Wednesday 24 Begons with Pleasant weather
and light Breeze from N. C.
employed stowing down oil
in jaffa hatch way
Lat 12 39 North
Long 142 12 Chronometer

Thursday 25 Begons with fine weather
Wind from N. C. by N. E
storing N. W. by N. E
Lat 88 14 00 N

Friday 26 Through the day fine Breeze
from N. C. to N. E
storing N. W. by N. E
employed setting up the oaks
Lat 88 15 29 N
Long. Chronom 144 48
