Monday 8th Through the day Pleasant breeze from East Lat obs 28.34 S

Tuesday 9th Strong breeze from East Lat 28.34 S at 6 P.m. Spoke ship comes of Pembroke 2140 lbs Lat obs 28.46 S Long same as 11.25 East

Wednesday 10th Begins with strong breeze from East Strong breeze Lat 29.50 N 4th

Thursday 11th Through the day fine weather but strong breeze from East Lat obs 28.12-13 East

Friday 12th Through the day strong breeze from East Spoke ship history of New Bedford 13 months and now black oil Lat obs 28.54 North Struck a whale and lost him

Sat 13th Through the day strong gale at 2 P.m. Saw Males Lat obs 28.54 North Struck a whale and lost him at 7 A.m. persisted cutting Lat obs 28.53 S Long 171 W E

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Sunday 14th Through the day Nothing Remarkable Lat obs 29.20 N

Monday 15th Through the day Wind at East Lat obs 29.24 S

Tuesday 16th 18 day preceding To End of day Lat obs 29.26 S

Wednesday 17th Beginning with light breeze from East at 2 P.m. hauled to West W. all this time there seems no signs of whales Lat obs

Thursday 18th Through the day fine weather Wind to Westward at 5 A.m. Saw 4 large whales at 6 P.m. and harbor boat fastened and at same time got back by 10 P.m. however saved the whale at 9 A.m. got him to ship 2 boats in Chaise of the other whales at 10 P.m. returned on board with out success Day ends with the calm cutting in the whale I kept obs 29.20 N Lat obs Long by Chronometer 171.20 E

Friday 19th Through the day Nothing Remarkable but some Rain Lat obs 29.41 N Long 171.23 E
