Sunday 21st Begins with fine weather
at 6 A.M.
at 11 P.M. finished Bailing
Turned up on deck 112 barrels
Lat. 28° 52' N
Long by obs 172° 09' East

Monday 22nd Begins with pleasant weather
Winds from S.E.
at 8 A.M. sent a sperm
Whale going N.W.
at 10 A.M. killed him
took him to ship
Lat. 29° 19' N

Tuesday 23rd at 2 P.M. sent 3 large
Whales going N.W.
killed all the boats and
killed one at 11 P.M. got
him to ship
at 5 A.M. began cutting
at 10 A.M. ship Royal
Admiral of London 22 m
sent 1000 lbs
to day ends with fine weather
employed cutting and Bailing
Lat. 29° 29' N

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Wednesday 24th Begins with the Specially
weather finished cutting in
the forenoon
at 9 A.M. took in the
head of one and finished
Bailing
Day ends Specially
sent a ship to Leonard
Lat. 29° 35' N

Thursday 25th Day Begins with Specially
weather with Rain
Winds variable
and ends to employ us
Bailing Lat. 29° 40' N

Friday 26th Through the day Specially
with showers of Rain
at 3 A.M. finished Bailing
turned up on deck 160 lbs
Day ends in Lat. 29° 50' N

Sat 27th Begins with the Specially weather and
Rain Winds S.W.
sent a sail to S.E.
sent Breached to windward
supplied them to be Sperm
Lat. 29° 55' N

Sunday 28th Through the day Specially
with the Specially Rain
however an Employee standing
down all in after hours
Lat. 29° 02' N
Long by Chronometer 171° 00'
