from N.E.
Sailing to O.S.C. under double
Reefed top sails
Lat obs 29° 45' N

Monday 30th
Strong gails from N.E.
Lay under main top sail
Saw a ship to the westward
Lat obs 28° 58' N

Tuesday 1st Oct
Strong gails from N.E.
Laying under main top sail
Lat obs 29° 45' N

Wednesday 2nd Oct
Boys with fine weather
Wind S.E.
Sailed to N.W. by W.
Lat obs 29° 23' N
Long Chronometer 172° 42' E

Thursday 3rd
First Part fine weather
Wind S.E. strong N.W. by W.
Saw Porpoises & porpoises
Lat obs 28° 55' N

Friday 4th
Through the day fine weather
Wind S.E. strong by S.E.
Lat obs 29° 32' N
Long obs 173° 22' East

Sat 5th
Through the day fine weather
and light breezes from S.E.
Lat obs 29° 27' N
Long obs 173° 48' East

Oct 1833

Sunday 6th
Boys with fine weather
and light airs from N.W. by W.
Saw humpers &c
Small prospect of Sperm
Whales
Day ends with calm weather
Lat obs 29° 16' N
Long obs 174° 06' East

Monday 7th
Through the day fine weather
Wind to Eastward
Saw Porpoises and Sperm
Lat obs 29° 17' N

Tuesday 8th
fine weather Wind S.E.
Sailing S.E.
Lat obs 29° 07' N

Wednesday 9th
Boys with fine weather
Wind S.W.
at 5 A.M. Saw Sperm Whales
Loaded all the Boats
and filled one 3d barrel one
it begins to blow strong
Ship under Double Reefed
top sails
took the ship to the Whales
and made fast with 3 inch chain
in wearing ship Port side from
him hoisted the Boat and got
him Long Side Port side again
Loaded the Boat again of the
hip so under the day
Strong gails and heavy sea
No obs
