it is bad landing

29th

Thin with Sotter Remark
at 6 P.M. Van Thet
bearing S.W.

Wednesday
30th

at 2 P.M. spoke
Ship. I. McCoy Market
and Kribben and Bede
to Cook the day

Thursday
31st

at 4 A.M. made sail
to Enso at meridian
Rings to carbure in
Halls half hour in 14 fathoms
water small power

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Friday
28th

This is a fair harbor and
plenty of Wood and Water
to be had handy to the ship
also. If the ship is well
supplied with such articles
as the natives want
they may be supplied
with such. Kribben as
the Island of old
such as Potatoes yams
and hogs goats &c.
at this season there is
plenty of Rain
