Thursday 18	at 6 A.M. got under way Wind at South quite strong for the Islands of Stehute So. Ends the day
Friday 19	Begins with fine breeze from South at 2 P.M. sent a boat on shore to procure some tea for the people at 5 P.M. returned on board made sail to Northward middle and latter part calm Lat obs 14-19 South
Saturday 20	through the day light airs and variable some time calm Lat obs 16 33 South Steute on Enevo in sight
Sunday 21	Begins with Calms and ends with light airs and variable Lat obs 16 44 South
Sat 22	at 4 P.M. took a light breeze from South through the night and latter part of the day squally with heavy rains Lat obs 15-45 S

Monday 23	this day as yesterday Boring Squally with Wind from South to N.E. Lat obs 14-21 South
Tuesday 24	Begins with thick weather Wind from East to North Lat obs 13-34 South
Wednesday 25	Nothing remarkable but light variable winds and Squally with Rain Lat obs 13-18 South
Thursday 26	through the day much as the day preceding Lat obs 10 00 South
Friday 27	through the day variable Winds from S.W. to N.E. and Squally with Rain Lat obs 9-10 S
Saturday 28	Light Wind and variable the Chase took of Duty Lat obs 8-18 South
Sunday 29	Light Breeze and variable made took of Duty Lat obs 7-14 South Long Lunar 141-48 W
