strong to Westward
Day ends in late of
No. 1 3-44 South

Friday 3
begins with light drizzle from
at 9 A.M. San Sporn
Whaler looks all the
boats and killed 6
look 5 of them to ship
and put in 3 and begin
to sail at 3-46 South

Saturday 4
at 3 P.M. land and take
to the ship the other whale
but him in good mood
Day ends in late
at 3-46 South
