Strong to North
at 5-40 taken to 1-38
Saw 1 or 2 Islands to 1-38
Saw Porpoise and black
Lat 1-36 South

Sunday 20th
Begins with fine weather
Strong to South
Lat 1-47 South
Long by Chron 160-00

Monday 21st
Begins with fine weather
Winds S.W. Strong to the
South westward
Lat 1-58 South

Tuesday 22nd
Through the day fine weather
and light wind
Lat 1-19 South

Wednesday 23rd
Nothing remarkable
Lat 1-36 miles South

Thursday 24th
as day preceding so is this day
Lat 1-24 South

fine weather wind light
and variable
