Long Chron on 165° W

Tues 6<sup>th</sup> Begins with fine weather  
Wind ESE  
Lat 18 on the Equator

Wed 7<sup>th</sup> Through the day fine  
weather and light breeze  
from NW by N. Drizzling  
Lat 18 9 miles N

Thurs 8<sup>th</sup> Through the day fine weather  
and light breeze from ESE  
Drizzling NW by N  
Breeze anew flying light  
Lat 18 10 miles N

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Friday 9<sup>th</sup> Begins with fine weather  
Wind ESE. Sailed at  
11 A.M. all sail set the  
sloop dray bound to  
Iapuan with 2600 lbs  
Sperm oil on board  
and hope to get 5000  
hundred more but am  
fearful shall fall short  
however God will do  
all things for the best
