Begins with fine breeze
from Cape to Cape N.W.
Had a ship starting N.W.
Lat 18-04 North
Long by Chron on 43-2 W

Tuesday
Begins with Pleasant weather
Wind N.W. by E Course N.W.
at 1 P.M. Long by Land
was 43-28 W
Day ends with fine weather
and the first gull heard
this day Lat 18-39 N

Starks New Bedford

February 1831

Wednesday
Begins with fine weather
from Cape to Cape N.W.
begins to feel considerable gulf
Lat 18-20 North

Thursday
Begins with fine weather
Wind N.W. by E Course N.W.
Had a ship starting
starting West at 1 P.M.
by Land Long 43-28 W
Lat 18-21 North

Friday
Through the day pleasant breeze
from Cape to Cape N.W.
and heavy swell from N.W.
Course N.W.
Long by Land 49-4 W
at 1 P.M.
Day ends in Lat 22-49 N

Saturday
Begins with Pleasant breeze
from Cape to Cape N.W.
at 9 A.M. spoke schooner
Brig William Van
of Elizabeth town Santa Antigua
30 days out

Lat 18-24 29 N
Long Land 63-26 W
at 1 P.M. heavy the sky dark
only Boarded the ship Whaling
