of St Helena thirty miles off.

off Island of St Helena
the Last Seven days off the Island
of St Helena fine weather saw
a number of Whale Ships goin
to anchor



Friday March 17th

this day fine weather
at 11 A. M. came to anchor at
Georgetown St Helena

Thursday March 23rd

this day good weather at 3 P. M.
broke the anchor steering S.

Sunday March 26th Lat 18° 15' S

Long 04° 00' W
this day fine weather light trade
steering S. E. with all sail out

Wednesday March 28th Lat 06° 30' S

Lat 02° 00' E
this day Strong Breeze from S.
steering S. E. saw a School
of Black fish go to the Westward
