 one

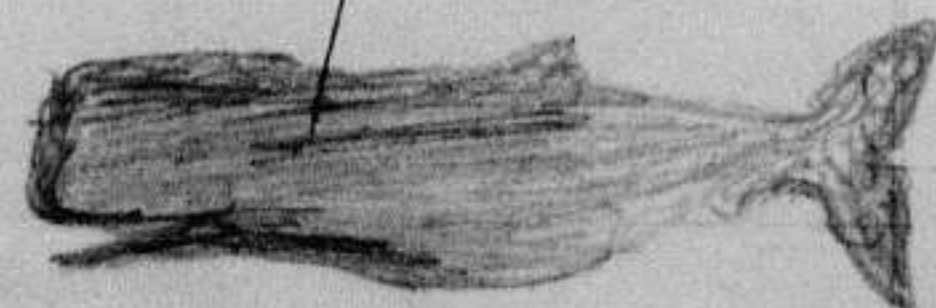
