Fri July 27th
 This day began with strong S.W. wind
 later part the same
 Lat 37-32
 Lon 73-21

Sat July 28th
 This day began with Fresh N.E. wind
 later part moderated under short
 sail all day
 Lat 37-24
 Lon 72-40

Sun July 29th
 This day began with calm later part
 Fresh S.W. wind
 Lat 37-46
 Lon 72-30

Mon July 30th
 This day began with strong S.W. wind
 Steering N.N.E.
 Lat 38-51
 Lon 72-03
