Saturday March 25th

This day commences with light breeze from the S. at 10 made sail steering on a course to make out to stowen near remainder of the sail in company with the Dove took in sail Sat no observation

Sunday March 26th

This day commences squally with fresh breeze from the S. at daylight made sail & steered S. by E. in company with the Dove carried sail all night Lat 43 28 Long 52 38

Monday March 27th

This day commences pleasant with light breeze from the S. steering S. by E. with all sail set saw in company with the Dove saw several fin-backs this ends Lat 42 08 S Lat

Tuesday March 28th

This day commences pleasant with light breeze from the S. steering S. by E. with all sail set in company with the Dove in the afternoon wind hauled to the W. hoisted all took in the maintopgallant sail Lat 41 06

Wednesday March 29th

This day commences pleasant with fresh breeze from the S. steering on the wind under double reefed topsails & courses at 9 took in the topsails & set the maintopgallant sail saw nothing Lat set no observation

Thursday March 30th

This day commences cloudy with light breeze from the S. steering on the wind with all sail set in the afternoon it came on squally with fresh breeze double reefed the topsails & took in the jib & mainsail saw nothing Lat 38 44 Lat no altitude

Friday March 31st

This day commences squally with fresh breeze from the N. W. steering on the wind under double reefed topsails & courses at 9 took in the wind hauled to the S. W. steering S. blowing very fresh took in mainsail at night it came on to blow hard took in sail & heaved too Lat no observation
