This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the S.E. steering at N.W. by N. with all sail set saw nothing at night took in the lower studding sail

This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the S. steering at N.W. by N. with all sail set saw nothing thus ends pleasant

This day commences cloudy with fresh breezes from the S.E. steering at N.W. with all sail set at night it came on squally took in the topgallant sail & fore topgallant sail

Saturday Apr 22<sup>nd</sup>

This day commences squally with light & baffling winds & sails steering at N.W. by N. with all sail set saw nothing thus ends

Lat 29 39 S Long 9 58 E

Sunday Apr 23<sup>rd</sup>

This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the N. steering at N.W. by N. took in the topmast studding sail & gaff top sail thus ends pleasant

Lat 28 31 S Long 6 29 E

Monday Apr 24<sup>th</sup>

This day commences squally with fresh breezes from the N.W. steering at N.W. by N. with all sail set & courses jib & spanker in the afternoon the main yard hauled to the S.W. blowing fresh with the top sail steering at N.W. thus ends
