This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the S.E. steering N. by W. with all sail set in the afternoon the wind died away saw several pinbacks thus ends
Got no observation

Thursday Apr 27th

This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the S.E. steering N. by W. with all sail set saw nothing thus ends

Friday Apr 28th

This day commences squally with fresh breezes from the S.E. steering N. by W. with all sail set at night took in the main royal & lower steering sail thus ends squally
Lat 22.16 S Long 00.43 E

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Saturday Apr 29th

This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the S.E. steering N. by W. with all sail set in the afternoon steered off thus ends
Lat 20.3 S Long 1.10 W

Sunday Apr 30th

This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the S.E. steering N. by W. with all sail set saw nothing at night steered N. by W. thus ends
Lat 18.33 S Long 1.35 W

Monday May 1st

This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the S.E. steering N. by W. with all sail set saw nothing thus ends
Lat 18.20 S Long 2.57 W

Tuesday May 2nd

This day commences pleasant with light breezes from the S.E. steering N. by W. with all sail set at day saw one ship ahead at 11 A.M. saw the Isle of Helena steered for it at 5 P.M. saw a school of sperm whales leaved but they were a going very quick & could not catch them at night double reefed the top sail steering for the land thus ends
