This day commences pleasant with a strong breeze from the S.E. steering on the wind under double reefed topsails and courses saw nothing
Lat 15, 12 N and Long 26, 20 W

Saturday August 20th

This day commences pleasant with a strong breeze from the S.E. steering on the wind under whole topsails and courses in the afternoon set the m in topgallant sail saw nothing
Lat 17, 04 N and Long 26, 26 W

Sunday August 21st

This day commences pleasant with a fresh breeze from the S.E. steering on the wind with all sail set saw nothing
Lat 18, 48 N and Long 26, 48 W

This day commences squally with a strong breeze from the South East steering on the wind under double reefed topsails and courses saw several finbacks
