commences pleasant with a calm in the afternoon a light breeze sprung up from the E, S, E steering on the wind with all sail set saw one ship at night calm thus ends

commences pleasant squally with light breezes from the W, N, W at daylight saw the Island of Flores steered for it all day at 11 o'clock saw a shoal of blackfish lowered & struck & brought them along side the vessel

Wednesday Aug 23rd

commences pleasant with squally with fresh breezes from the W, N, W standing off & on the Island of Flores under double reefed topsails & courses at 7, A, M lowered the boat & went ashore at 5, P, M the boat came off brought off several hogs & fowls &c at 6, P, M made sail & started for Fayall steering S, E

Thursday Aug 24th

commences pleasant with a fine breeze from the N steering S, E with all sail set at 9 A, M saw the Island of Fayall run for it at night stood off & on saw several ships
