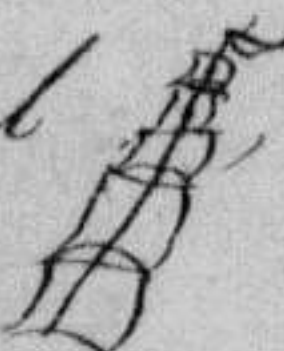


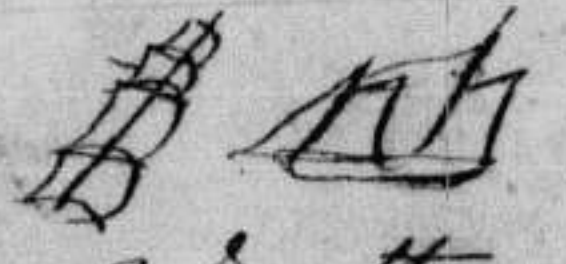
Barque Pembroke

commences pleasant with light breezes from the N.W. beat up into Bayall Harbor & come to anchor Capt. & boats crew went ashore broke out & heeled the ship & found the leak on the out side

Sunday Aug 27th
commences squally blowing a strong gale from W.S.W. laying at anchor in Bayall bay at 1st A.M. had to slip our cable leaving the Point of land & a reef of rocks under our lee got round & got sail on just in time to save the masts & rigging to our slipping we had ~~two~~ a large four fold tackle on our chain to support the mizzen but it capsized the masts & rendered it impossible to hold on longer steered on the wind till we got clear & then kept off & run down to the leeward and luffed to

Wednesday Sept 6th
commences pleasant with light breezes from the E steering S by W with all sail set in the afternoon steered S by W half W thus ends Latt, 26, 41, N Long, 25, 47, W

Thursday Sept 7th
commences pleasant with a fine breeze from the E steering S by W half W with all sail set saw nothing thus ends pointed the boats Latt 24, 50, N Long 25, 42, W

Friday Sept 8th
commences pleasant with a fine breeze from the E steering S by W half W with all sail set saw nothing got out the new boats ends squally Latt 22, 42 Long
